Hillside is proud to tell you that we have completed the \$6.2 million Campaign for Hillside. We are truly grateful for the Peachtree Atlanta Kiwanis Club's pledge of \$2000. Thank you! The wide support we received from the foundation community was a key factor in our success.

When we outlined our goals for the campaign, the primary one was to increase our capacity for treating severely emotionally disturbed youth. There were also many improvements and additions we wished to make across campus. We are happy to report that we accomplished the following:

- Purchase of the 4.8 acre adjacent property from Georgia Power Company and relocating our administration and therapeutic foster care staff into the two-story office building;
- Build out of the attached one-story structure to contain work areas for community intervention program staff; a group therapy room, and a large training room;
- Addition of several single bedrooms and a community/visitors room in three of the four residential cottages;
- Creation of a centralized, professional kitchen to serve the dietary needs of the whole campus;
- Renovation of a house which served several past functions to become an open campus girls' transition unit;
- Refurbishing of the gym to add new flooring, a lowered ceiling, improved lighting and repainting;
- Conversion of the former administration building to become a clinical services facility with added therapy, work and family rooms;
- Addition of a second exam room, secured medical records area and a charting room in the clinic; and
- Adding single bedrooms in both the boys' and girls' wings of the Evaluation and Stabilization unit; expanded classrooms; and improved staff work areas.

Please extend our heartfelt thanks to the Foundation's trustees for their confidence in Hillside and their generous support. We will shortly be sending out invitations to a dedication and truly hope you can attend.
