Our guest speaker today was Dr. Paul Stephen Hudson, Chairman of the Department of Business and Social Sciences at Georgia Perimeter College (Clarkston Campus) and former Registrar and Lecturer in History at Oglethorpe University. As an expert on Time Capsule and a Founding Member of the International Time Capsule Society, Dr. Hudson shared with us much information about Time Capsule which included the following:

1. Time Capsule is a sealed container holding objects of social and scientific interest and everyday use, with pictures, films, and description of contemporary civilization, to be opened in the distant future.
2. The name "Time Capsule" was adopted by the Westinghouse Electric Corporation for a slim torpedo-shaped container which was buried in 1938 at the New York World's Fair and scheduled to be opened in 6939 AD.
3. A more comprehensive contemporary record, called the Crypt of Civilization, is in a large underground room at Oglethorpe University which was sealed in 1940 and to be opened in 8113 A.D. This Time Capsule project was planned and implemented during the presidency of Dr. Thornwell Jacobs (1915-1943).
